Specific:

- Assume the role, functions and tasks of professionals dedicated to the educational treatment of diversity
- Use the most appropriate approaches to educate people with diverse needs
- Manage national and international regulations applicable to the education of persons with special needs
- Adapt national and international experiences to the educational treatment of diversity
- 5.Handle the techniques and instruments necessary to detect and evaluate people with diverse needs
- Design and carry out appropriate curricular adaptations and educational intervention programs for practical application with people with diverse special needs
- Implementing methodological innovations for the educational treatment of diversity
- Appropriate use of teaching materials and technological resources adapted to the educational treatment of special needs

- 10.Choose and implement the necessary methodological strategies to promote the personal development of the skills of people with special needs

- 12.Promote attitudes and behaviour conducive to the integration and inclusion of people with diverse special needs in educational, family and social contexts
