

Average mark on academic record

- Holders of Spanish degrees. The average mark out of ten as pes

If you have not completed the degree which qualifies you for master's studies, the average mark must be calculated on the basis of the marks obtained at the moment you register.

The record is obtained by applying the following formula:

- $AM = \frac{\sum Si * NCi}{\sum NCi}$.

AM = Average mark as per record.

Si = Score for each subject

NCi = Number of credits for each subject

$\sum NCi$ = Total number of credits

For those subjects without any numerical mark, the following equivalences will be used to calculate the average mark

- Distinction: 10 points
- Outstanding: 9 points
- Good: 7.5 points
- Pass: 5.5 points

Validated subjects or credits for which no mark is specified on the validating document will not be considered when calculating the average mark.

- Holders of non-Spanish degrees.

The average mark as per the academic record will be stated according to the marking system used in the issuing country.
